Who should tryout?

- Arrive 15 minutes prior to your scheduled tryout.
- Fill out necessary paperwork at the site.
- Come prepared to play. Bring your tennis racquet and dress comfortably.

How does it work?

- Testers will be evaluating applicants according to their age group.
- The evaluation will be based on on-court skills and point situations.
- The tryouts are outdoors. In the event of rain, please call the tryout site for more info.
- Selected players will be contacted via mail.
