QuickStart TENNIS

Receive tennis instruction, match play and invitation to QuickStart Tennis Championships

Homework Help & TUTORING

Daily homework help and tutoring strengthen children's academic skills and fosters caring and positive relationship with adults and peers

Athletic INSTRUCTION

Sports activities include basketball, baseball, soccer, double dutch and other team sports

Cultural ACTIVITIES

Program offers story telling, service learning, drama and classes such as salsa and yoga

Educational PROJECTS

Specialized projects can include Lego Robotics, Model United Nations and chess tournaments

Health & NUTRITION

Includes health awareness classes, nutritional guidance and life skills training

Events range from museum field trips to the NYJTL QuickStart Tennis Championships, the Disney Kids Day Parade and more

FREE NYJTL PROGRAMS

Aces Clubs PROGRAMS

Tennis-themed after-school and summer camp programs promote academic enrichment and life skills through tennis.

Advanced TRAINING

Experienced players receive year-round training, travel to local and national competitions, and entry fees.

Arthur Ashe GUIDANCE

Individuals and families receive educational support, counseling services, and assistance with admissions and scholarships.

Community TENNIS

Free tennis instruction, practice, and match play for children ages 6-18 years old. Includes special trips and events.

Schoolyard TENNIS

Schools receive teacher training and equipment by including introductory tennis activities as part of their curriculum.

USTA QuickStart

QuickStart Tennis is a play format designed for kids 10 and under which utilizes specialized equipment, shorter court dimensions and modified scoring.
