2023 US Open Championship Tickets to Benefit NYJTL

Dear Friend of NYJTL:

Thank you for your past support of the US Open Ticket Benefit for New York Junior Tennis & Learning. All of the net proceeds will support community tennis programs and comprehensive after school programs that incorporate tennis, academic enrichment, healthy living and character development for thousands of inner-city youth. We want to thank and acknowledge the USTA for allowing us the privilege of using US Open tickets to raise these much needed funds.

We will start to allocate seats for the **2023 US Open** on January 25, 2023. Enclosed are our 2023 prices and applications. If you wish to order, please complete the application and return it to us with a 50% deposit. The balance will be due March 3, 2023. If you would like an extended payment schedule, please contact Skip or Alex.

Previous year's purchasers will receive **preference** to renew if their application and deposit are received **by January 24, 2023**, unless such renewal is impossible due to the schedule changes or such renewal is not in the best interest of NYJTL's overall fundraising goals. Criteria include: a) previous two year's purchaser; b) previous support of NYJTL's other charitable events and programs; c) ticket availability.

Also please note:

- 1. <u>Please especially note</u>: Again, there will be only mobile tickets this year. Our staff are prepared to assist you in this process.
- Should the USTA make any changes prior to the 2023 Open to our present understanding of the 2023 schedule and pricing that would significantly change the value of a particular session, you may change your request without penalty or cancel and receive a full refund. Also, NYJTL reserves its right to change its prices to reflect the changed value.
- The terminology for seats in Ashe Stadium in order of distance from the court is as follows: courtside boxes, luxury suites, loge boxes, and promenade seats. In the Armstrong and Grandstand Stadiums, all of our seats are in the reserved Courtside box category.
- 4. We continue to offer rain insurance for tickets in Ashe Stadium, Armstrong Stadium and the Grandstand Stadium since NYJTL does not take these risks, and the donor does. Although Ashe Stadium and the Armstrong Stadium have retractable roofs, it is indicated on the USTA's weather policy that should the retractable roof(s) become unavailable, then their inclement weather policy would be put into effect for sessions 1-20. You should estimate that the coverage and cost will be similar to the 2022 costs. More detailed information may be found on the attached yellow sheet which describes 2022 coverage. Since coverage is keyed to the USTA cancellation policy, we will not finalize coverage until the USTA publishes its 2023 policy.
- 5. The difference between NYJTL's cost of the ticket and our price is a charitable contribution to NYJTL.

We are greatly appreciative of your support. 

Most of the courtside boxes are configured in groups of 8 – 4 below and 4 above. With a few exceptions, the balance are configured in groups of 6, either as 6 in a row, or 3 below and 3 above. Seat numbering starts and ends at the aisle, as shown below.
